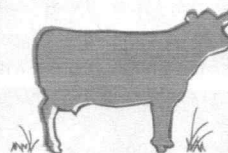

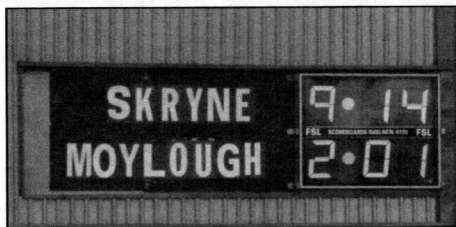

SKRYNE LADIES GFC

Skryne Girls March On



Skryne U16 girls took a further step in their bid for silverware this season when they did a demolition job on their semi-final opponents Moylough in Skryne on 9th May. Skryne came into this semi-final on the back of a number of huge wins and Lizzie Moreland bagged a goal two minutes into the game. Then Ruth Moore Skryne full forward put the ball between the opponent's uprights on the 4th minute. Ruth had just returned from an injury which kept her out of the game for eight weeks but showed no ill effects from this, as she, Catriona Keoghan and Lizzie Moreland added further points for the home side without reply. This left Skryne ahead 1-4 to 0-0 ten minutes into the half.

Skryne playing with the stiff breeze were dominant in all sectors of the pitch and corner forward Lizzie Moreland clocked up two goals in the 13th and 15th minutes respectively. Moylough were now in real trouble but they claimed their first score of the evening in the 16th minute from a free kick to narrow the gap by a point. This score was cancelled out when Ruth Moore added a further point for the home side followed by a goal from Catriona Keoghan and a point from Eimear Clarke to push the home side further ahead and almost out of reach by the 19th minute. The Skryne midfield pair Margret Fox and Niamh O'Brien

were winning the battle in this sector and Margaret got on the scoreboard with a point from play going into the closing stages of the half. Catriona Keoghan was proving a real thorn in the opposition's side as she slipped through for another point added to by a Eimear Clarke goal on the 23rd minute. Moylough made a rare breakthrough on the 25th minute when they bagged a goal. This was cancelled out by a Holly Callaghan goal for the home side in the 29th minute to leave the scores at the break: Skryne: 6-8, Moylough 1-1.

Ruth Moore was back on the scoreboard again with a goal just four minutes into the second half and a point two minutes later. This was followed by two points from Lizzie Moreland on the 9th and 10th minutes. Moylough netted a goal in the 13th minute to leave the scores at the stage at 7-11 to 2-1 in favour of Skryne. This was to prove Moylough's last score of the evening with the remaining scores came from the home side. These scores were as follows: Eimear Clarke scored a point from play in the 14th minute followed by a Ruth Moore goal two minutes later, another Eimear Clarke point on the 19th minute was added to by another from Ruth Moore a few minutes later. The final score came from substitute Eimear O'Brien who bagged a well taken goal to leave the scores at the final whistle: Skryne 9-14; Moylough 2-1

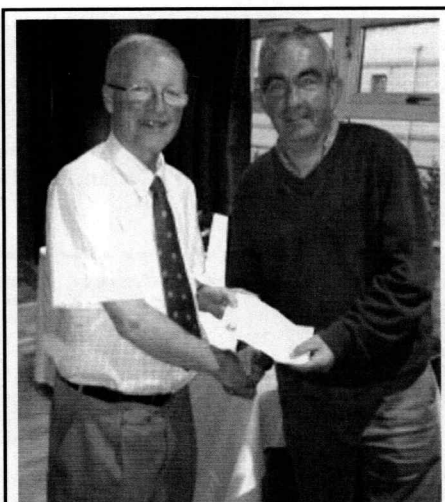



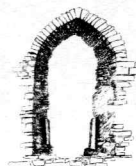

DAWN RUN Con/td

Over 500 runners from all across the North East are expected to take part in the annual Tara Dawn Run on the Hill of Tara this June to raise funds for Our Lady's Children's Hospital, Crumlin.

Beginning at 4:00am on Saturday 18th of June, the four kilometre "fun-run" is anticipated to grow to its largest number of participants yet as people travel from all across the North East and beyond to take part in this novel event.

Now in its fifth year, The Tara Dawn Run has established itself as an event with the X-factor that attracts people to run on the seat of the High Kings of Ireland around the summer solstice each June. The event has raised over €25,000 to date for Our Lady's Children's Hospital, Crumlin and is again raising money for the same cause in 2011.

Local organisers James Gibbons of Skyrne, County Meath and Shay Sheridan of Dunleer, County Louth said: "Last year we didn't get any sleep during the night before the event at all. From mowing the course to setting up the post-race barbeque, there is something to do all the time in that final few hours. This will be the biggest event yet and a challenge for everyone involved but when you see the result, it makes it all worthwhile. People can even come along this year dressed in their pyjamas if they want. We will take donations from anyone regardless how dressed they are!" the guys continued.

Johann Fox, Corporate Fundraising Manager with the Children's Medical & Research Foundation at Our Lady's Children's Hospital, Crumlin was quick in his praise for the organizers but also sent out a plea to those considering

taking part: "If you think about it, you are asking people to come to one of Ireland's most historical of sites in the pitch black on a Saturday morning and run for 4km. Credit is due to everyone who will take part and all we can say is that the hospital really needs the support of everyone in the North-East on June 18th."

This year's funds will go towards providing evening services for teenagers attending the hospital as well as contributing to the expansion of the new Cardiac unit due to be built in the second half of 2011.
