Mr. Donal Conway, President of the FAI, brought the 'Festival Of Football' to Skryne Tara at Ross Cross in July.

On a beautiful summers evening the facilities at Ross Cross were in splendid condition and drew admiration from the President and all the FAI Officials who were present on this momentous occasion for the club.

They commented on how such a small club had access to proper Dressing Rooms and a Clubhouse capable of catering for not only the 'home' team but also the 'away' team, referee and officials by offering a welcoming cup of tea on arrival. They may have been influenced by the combined efforts of the Ladies Committees of Skryne Tara AFC and Tara Athletic club. Therefore we must thank these ladies, particularly Aisling, Lisa, Caroline, Schira and Mary with ntheir younger helpers for all their hard work in providing the goodies on the night and bringing tea and cakes out to the guests on the field as well as those who ventured inside.

The President also commented on the condition of the playing surface and stated it compared favourably with some of the International venues the Republic of Ireland team has played on over the years. It also drew compliments from all the FAI visitors which included former International players Mick McCarthy, Richard Dunne, Paul Osam and Irish Ladies International and Manchester City Player Megan Campbell.

It was a great honour for the club to welcome the present Republic of Ireland Manager Mick McCarthy to Ross Cross as we were one of the few clubs who had that privilege. The 'big' man proved to be very approachable and mingled with young and old alike all through the hour long visit. Autographs and pictures etc were no problem to Mick as he patiently posed for and spoke to everybody who approached him. The same could be said for all the visitors on the night and former Internationals Richard Dunne and Megan Campbell attracted a host of admirers and seemed to revel in the attention

Master of ceremonies for the evening and Chief organiser of the event Val Finegan welcomed the visiting party and introduced them to the crowd. He thanked the President, Mr Donal Conway, for including Skryne Tara on the rota of visits which took place over a period of ten days and wished him well in his quest to remain as president of the FAI on the following Weekend at the AGM in Trim.

Val then asked Dermot Carty, Secretary of Skryne Tara, to introduce some of the people the club had invited to meet the delegation from the FAI. These included Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer of Skryne GFC, Senan McGrath, Dan O'Leary and Ross Phillips respectively. Former Manager of the Meath team Mick O'Dowd. Former player and captain of the Meath team, All-Star Trevor Giles. Top jockey, who is still recovering from injuries received while race riding in one of the most dangerous sports, Barry Geraghty.

We also had Gerry Gorman, Secretary of the North East Football League (formerly the Meath & District League). Gerry has been ever present as a highly respected official of the NEFL since its inception in 1980, serving that organisation excellently in a number of positions. He has been a very good friend to Skryne Tara over the years and we were privileged to have him present on that evening especially as we were one of a small number of the 50 clubs or so in Meath that Gerry attended with the FAI delegation. We very much appreciated his presence along with his wife Deirdre.

We also had James Finnerty, former Skryne Tara underage player now with Bohemians in the League Of Ireland, having had a spell in England with Aston Villa and Rochdale Football Clubs. Catthal Dervan from Dunshaughlin, Journalist and FAI Official was also present as was another Journalist, Meath Chronicle Reporter Jimmy Geoghegan.

We had Donal Gaynor, former Chairperson of the Meath & District League who played for both origional clubs - Skryne Rangers and Tara. Also present was Dave McCarthy, Chairperson of Tara Athletic Club who have been very supportive of the whole venture and whose Grounds we share. Thanks Dave.

A number of invited people were unable to be present for different reasons - original member of Skryne Rangers Padraig Finnerty was absent as was Brian Crocock and Mick Fitzsimons original members of Tara FC. These men were involved with the original clubs before they merged to become Skryne Tara. Sadly, we also remember three men who have passed on, and who would have been honoured to to be present, Paddy Browne (Skryne Rangers) and Tom Leahy and Sean Faulkner (Tara) were stalwarts of what is now Skryne Tara FC.

The club would like to thank all who had an input in making this event such a success and we have been rewarded by the FAI since that evening and the benefits will seen in improvements to the Grounds and Clubhouse in the near future.

We also want to thank all our sponsors (too many to mention here) for all their help and support during the year. 

Our next outing is to Black Bush on 21st September.


COMMUNITY GAMES
